

Class Rules and Guidelines

Blue/Red Schooling Hunters: Open to anyone as a schooling class. Will be given a blue or red as a score. No ribbons in this class. It can be ridden as many times as needed, but will be charged for number of trips schooled. Will be ridden as your second hunter trip. Open card (crossrails—2'6")

Beginner Division: Open to all riders in their 1st or 2nd year of showing over fences. Fences will not exceed 18". Simple or flying changes are allowed. Rider may not enter into any other division at this show.

Baby Green Hunters: Open to all horses and ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing over fences of 2' in height. Fence will not exceed 2'

Novice Division: Open to all juniors and adult amateur riders who have not won more than 6 blue ribbons at fences 2' or above. Fences will not exceed 2'. May only cross enter into Tally Ho.

Low Hunters 2'3": Open to all horses/ponies and riders. Fences are 2'3"

Children's Pony: Open to all juniors and ponies. Small/mediums jump 2' and larges jump 2'6. Once heights are adjusted, fences will not be readjusted.

Pre-Child/Pre-Adult Hunters: Open to all juniors and adult amateurs. Fences will not exceed 2'6".

Modified Hunters: Open to all riders. Fences will not exceed 2'9".

Tally Ho: Open to all riders and all horses. Will be shown at the walk, trot and canter. May enter in one height A, B, or C. Must be shown during that height section.

Hunter Derby: Open to all riders who have shown in a full division with fences 2' and above. Riders may NOT move up in height for Derby from division shown in, but can drop down. To be shown at a choice of 2', 2'6", or 2'9" and will be judged as one class. Horses may enter only once. Riders may enter multiple horses. Formal attire is encouraged, but not required. This is a two round class and you will ride for the ribbons at the end. Cooler and money awarded. Must have at least 8 entries to award money.

Maiden Walk / Trot: Open to juniors and adult amateur riders who are in their 1st or 2nd year of showing. Flat classes will be split only if entries exceed 8 riders. May not cross enter into any other division.

Walk / Trot Crossrails: Open to beginner riders of any age on horses or ponies. Riders are not eligible for any other classes at this show. To be shown at the walk and trot. Flat classes will be split only if entries exceed 8.

Short Stirrup Crossrails: Open to riders of any age on horses or ponies. Riders are not eligible for any other classes at this show. Shown at the walk and trot. Simple changes allowed.

Leadline: Free to children who have not shown and will not show in any other class at this show.

No Stirrup Challenge Flat Class: Open to all riders. Stirrups are to be pulled or crossed before riders walk into the ring. To be judged as an equitation class. Trophy awarded for first place.

Good Hands Award: This is chosen by the Judge and goes to a rider in the Beginner Division who demonstrates the proper release and a soft hand.

Grooming/Braiding Award: Each rider, 18 and under, that groomed and braided their horse or pony for the show will be nominated for an award. There will be an award for each ring. Pick up your arm band from your trainer.

Rider Raffle: Each participating rider will be entered into a raffle for every horse show they attend in the 2018 Summer in CNY series. The raffle is for a David Fowler Tack Trunk and every horse/rider combination is entered to win. Only those showing are eligible to purchase tickets. Winner will be drawn at the awards banquet.

Trainer Raffle: Each participating trainer will be entered into a raffle for a bit box to be drawn at the awards banquet.
